



INTRODUCTION

Siddhartha Campus is a GAA certified nonprofit making community campus established with the plain intention of imparting quality education to the less privileged group deprived of higher education due to economic, geographical and other barriers. It has been implementing education to underprivileged students of the catchment areas in order to bring them into the mainstream of higher education. The target students primarily belong to rural areas of Kupwara and its neighbouring districts. The majority of students are the educationally disadvantaged girls and youths. The campus is situated in Roongrooghat Municipality, on the Srinagar-Pahalgam highway near Roongrooghat.

"To develop the campus as an ideal destination for educational excellence in higher education."

To impart quality education to the students in order to produce skilled and internationally competitive human resources to meet the requirements at national level.

Goals

- The community people, government bodies, stakeholders and University Grants Commission (UGC) have regularly supported the campus from the date of its establishment. Siddhartha Campus has been guided by the following goals:
1. To produce educationally excellent, dynamic and research oriented human resource to fulfill the needs of the country.
 2. To increase access of higher education to the girls, educationally disadvantaged persons, slums, marginalized and lower caste people.

 5. To enhance the creative and critical ability of the students through different curricular and extracurricular programmes.

 7. To enrich the library and auxiliary with advanced resources to broaden the knowledge and skills of the faculty and the students.
 8. To equip the campus with modern teaching learning aids along with sound physical facilities.
 9. To develop the campus as a center to be university and a research center.

Examination System and Results

Internal examinations are organized twice a year. The students have to compulsorily attend the internal examinations. The students are provided feedback through these examinations. The internal examination committee is basically responsible for conducting and managing internal exams. Internal examination schedules are set in the existence of calendar of the campus. Final results of each year are analyzed to see the improvements and weaknesses so that it will be benefited to make future plans.

Library / e-Library & Computer Lab

The campus contains separate Library building (constructed under Scheme C project of SHEP) which contains a rich collection of textbooks and reference books. It also contains different kinds of political, philosophical, cultural, religious books of national and international importance. In addition to these, daily newspapers, magazines and journals are available for daily use. The students can borrow 3 books at a time, books for 15 days. The library has a large collection of electronic, e-journals, and online resources. The students can use computer lab in their leisure.

Achievements

So far the campus has been able to gain significant achievements in various sectors. The campus has achieved National GAA award in June, 2020. It worked under Scheme C of the Second Higher Education Reform Project and Higher Education Reform Project of University Grants Commission (UGC). Currently it has been working under Nurturing Excellence in Higher Education Project of UGC. The campus has an excellent record of academic results at the national, provincial and district level. It gained first position among the girls in S.Ed. in the year 2007, and was awarded with Nagaland Education Award - 2007. A handsome number of students have been successful in the competitive examinations held by TSC, PSC as well as, financial and other organizations.
